3. New Business

- a. First Reading of the 2026 Budget – Derrick Jeffers, Business Administrator
 - i. Each ministry area brought to Derrick their dream budget and talked through this with Derrick.
 - ii. Giving through October is very good – we are slightly below budget but still have grown some. We should make up the difference in December as it usually does as we get a lot of contributions.
 - iii. Stewardship through this past Sunday shows we are only about \$269,000 away from total amount to meet what we did for 2025. Our average pledge is about 5% higher than it was last year and we still have time to continue to get additional pledges in. Derrick believes we will grow to a higher amount than we had last year.
 - iv. Staff is asking for about \$500,000 more in spending than we had in 2025. The plan is to have a balanced budget in January as we continue to walk through the rest of the stewardship campaign and what we can and cannot approve for next year. A lot of that growth is in the staff and benefits, it is not just in programming and spending.

 - i. Reviewed the Initiatives and the action items to show where we are on each item
 - ii. Had further discussion on some of the progress
- c. Bylaws Update – Dave Steane, Transitional Executive Pastor
 - i. We would need to make sure the congregation has enough time to review the bylaws. We would probably want this by mid to late December – even early January.
