

- State Department sponsored refugees in Colorado Springs are settled by Lutheran Family Services.
- First Pres partners with Lutheran Family Services to provide English classes.
- Extend a tangible expression of Christ's love to legal refugees.
- Enable these new neighbors to access English classes, jobs, school, appointments, etc.

- Touch of Love International brings transformation to families living in poor communities through microloans,
- small business training and Christian discipleship.
- Individuals or families experiencing material poverty can receive a loan through TOLI to purchase chicks and begin a poultry business.
- Individuals or families can generate income by breeding and raising chickens as broilers or layers to sell eggs.
- This gift keeps giving to the individuals and families and to others in the village, since the microloan will be recycled within the same community.





Church Car | Cuba

- Our sister church in Cuba, First Presbyterian Reformed Church of Havana (FPRC), is in need of a car to help minister to homebound church members.
- This car will help the pastor and other lay leaders minister directly to homes to visit people, take them to medical appointments and bring them to church.
- Cars in Cuba are few and hard to come by as they cannot be imported and must have a specific license plate code.
- FPRC has raised \$10,000 toward the purchase of this vehicle, but they need \$10,000 more to buy the car.

- Due to a lack of school dorms, students are constantly on the move from one place to another, or many are not able to live in the city.
- The Campus Ministry of Mongolia Campus Crusade for Christ (MCCC) committed to help their newly believing Christian students with housing.
- Your gift will help with housing for one of these students.

International Justice Mission Against Slavery | Guatemala

- Slavery is a \$150 billion industry with more than 40 million slaves globally.
- IJM works to put the slave trade out of business by rescuing those from slavery and other forms of violence, as well as arresting slave owners.
- In Guatemala, one in four adolescent girls is a victim of sexual violence.
- Help free the victims of sex trafficking, human slavery and other violent crimes of oppression.

- There is a critical need for training faithful and effective leaders who would shepherd the Iranian church into maturity in Christ.
- PARS trains leaders through an innovative and holistic BA program to help form emerging leaders toward living out the Great Commandment.



Pikes Peak Academy | Colorado Springs

- In its 27th year, Pikes Peak Academy is a Christian alternative high school dedicated to serving low-income families whose teens are at-risk of not graduating.
- Due to their commitment to share God and His word with their students, they receive no government funding.
- 80% of their students' tuition costs are underwritten by community partners who believe in the redemptive mission they have in the community with at-risk youth.
- Your gift will go toward a month's tuition scholarship for a low-income student.

- Young Life is a ministry with a mission in inviting young people to experience life as God designed it to be lived.

- Each summer, kids get the opportunity to go to camp with the leader that they have been walking with all year for the best week of their life.
- This week at summer camp kids get to step away from the pressures of everyday life and get to hear the message of God's love in a way that they can understand.

25. Water Bottles for Treatment System | Guatemala

- In order to meet the need for clean water, the Evangelical Church of Galilea created the first water purification system in their town of San Pablo.
- God is answering their prayer to provide two five-gallon bottles to at least 500 families. Currently 350 families have two bottles, leaving a need for 300 more bottles.
- This system will generate income through the sale of bottles, water and providing jobs.
- In only a year of operation, they are expanding their facility to purify a higher volume and meet demand.

- Young people with intellectual and developmental disabilities have fun, enriching experiences different from their everyday life through Capernaum club and camp.
- Young Life staff and volunteers model Christ's unconditional love and acceptance as they walk alongside their Capernaum friends and develop fulfilling relationships.
- At camp, they hear the Good News, grow in their faith and have a chance to get outside and develop self-confidence in who God has created them to be.
